Current / Future Releases

The latest version of IATS 8.5.0 will be arriving any day to sites via mail or DoD Safe. Please reach out to the help desk if you do not receive it soon. As a reminder, the DFAS provided Sybase license expired September 30, 2022, and all sites should be migrated to MSSQL. If your agency has procured a Sybase license of your own, you may contact the IATS helpdesk for rate updates for Sybase. This latest IATS version has many changes including policy changes, so it is imperative that you install it as soon as you receive it.

IATS Authority To Operate (ATO)

The IATS ATO was signed October 27, 2023. DFAS reciprocity can only be used for MSSQL versions 8.3 and later. If you are using version 8.2 or earlier, your IATS instance is unsupported. Please update to the latest version as soon as possible. If you need assistance with updating, please submit a myIT ticket to the IATS help desk.

Navy LOA changes effective 10/1

By direction of Navy FM&C, BUPERS migrated from SABRS to Navy ERP effective 10/1/2023 and the Bureau Control Number (BCN) and Authorization Accounting Activity (AAA) changed for Navy accounting for FY 24. At a minimum, they were required to change the AAA from the SABRS AAA to the Navy ERP AAA. It was also determined organizationally they would go back to the true BCN, vice the BCNs that SABRS forced them to create when they migrated in FY18. IATS 8.5 has been updated to include the hard coded BCN and AAA for FY24 and future years for all Navy accounting. Anything prior to FY24 will use the existing hard coded BCN and AAA for those years. It is imperative that you update to 8.5 to utilize these correct codes for any claims in FY24.

PET EXPENSE January 1, 2024

<u>CONUS</u>. A Service member may be authorized the reasonable and substantiated cost of mandatory microchipping, boarding fees, hotel service charges, licensing fees at the new PDS, and pet shipping fees if the member flies rather than drives or if the pet is shipped separately from the member. Reimbursement for the actual cost of all expenses is limited to \$550 per PCS move.

OCONUS. A Service member may be authorized the reasonable and substantiated cost of mandatory microchipping, quarantine fees, boarding fees, hotel service charges, licensing fees at the new PDS, testing titer levels for entry, and pet shipping fees if the member flies rather than drives, or the pet is shipped separately from the member. For transoceanic travel, use of Government or Government-procured transportation must be used, if available, or reimbursement for transportation costs is not authorized. Reimbursement for the actual cost of all necessary expenses described above in connection with the movement of a pet is limited to \$2,000 per PCS move.

October Rates error for Georgia

If you paid any claims where the traveler utilized the Integrated Lodging Program (ILP) location at Ft. Gordon/Ft. Eisenhower – Augusta, GA (Mero Area), Ft Benning and Robbins AFB the per diem may have been paid incorrectly as the rates increased for October but did not get updated. Please take a look and process an administrative correction voucher for the difference, if needed. The rates were corrected in the November update.

October Rates error for Alabama

If you paid any claims with travel dates of October where the TDY location was Huntsville or Redstone Arsenal, Alabama the per diem may have been paid incorrectly. In the October rate update they were not updated properly. The M&IE should have been \$74 but was left at \$59. Please take a look and process an administrative correction voucher for the difference, if needed. The rates were corrected in the November update.

IATS Version 8.5 Coming Soon!!

IATS version 8.5 is expected to be deployed late November or early December 2023. We recommend updating to this latest version as soon as possible as there are numerous fixes for improper payments and bugs fixes within IATS. Refer to the official documentation sent with the release for more detailed information on each issue and the fix.
